This 2-night, 3-day immersive tour offers the opportunity to learn about Budo (martial arts) and Kyudo (Japanese archery) in areas associated with Fujiwara no Hidesato, one of the first samurai from the 900s, and Nasu no Yoichi, a famed archer from the late Heian period in the 1100s. By following in the footsteps of these historical figures with a focus on Kyudo, you will experience the profound techniques and spiritual Japanese culture of Budo through hands-on Kyudo, tea ceremony, and Zen meditation programs.

Professor Emeritus of Shizuoka University, Doctor of Literature Chairman of the Japan Castle Foundation

Owada Tetsuo

A leading expert in Sengoku period history, Owada is well-known for his clear explanations on history programs, including NHK. He has also been responsible for historical supervision on many NHK Taiga dramas. Owada has authored numerous books on Sengoku warlords. He completed the doctoral program at Waseda University's Graduate School of Letters, Arts and Sciences, and holds a Doctor of Literature degree. After serving as a lecturer and professor at Shizuoka University's Faculty of Education, he became Professor Emeritus. In this lecture, Owada will provide insights into modern life by reflecting on the historical facts surrounding Sengoku warlords.

Statement of Travel Terms and Conditions (for Agent-Organized Domestic Tours Within Japan)

1.Application for travel and establishment of tour contract

In this case, the contract is not in effect at the time of the application of reservation, and the Traveler, within three days from the day following the day on which the Company have notified him/her of his/her acceptance of the reservation, and after the Company has informed him/her of the acceptance of the reservation, the submit an Application from and the application fee if the Traveler has no reservation, the application fee within this period, the Company deems that there has been or reservation.

2. Cancellation by the Company

If the number of travelers has not reached the minimum number of participants mentioned in the brochure. It shall inform the Traveler to the effect that the travel will be canceled prior to the 13th day (in case of a one day trip, the 3rd day), prior to the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel.

3. What is included and not included in the travel fee
